Dear Resident,

The Town of Vienna has received a number of complaints this past year regarding pickleball at Glyndon Park. We have listened to the concerns, adjusted scheduling and held discussions regarding parking with the pickleball community.

The current tennis/pickleball court schedule at Glyndon Park is as follows:

- Reservations to Town residents only and their guests seven days a week from 12noon to 8pm.
- Open play for tennis and pickleball restricted to 8am to 12noon on specific days:
  - Pickleball – Monday/Wednesday
  - Tennis – Tuesday/Thursday
  - Tennis/Pickleball – each sport gets a court Saturday and Sunday

The Town would like to know the impact pickleball currently has on your quality of life. On the reverse side of this letter is a survey. Regardless if pickleball does or does not negatively affect you, please complete the survey. We would like to obtain an accurate account of the impact of pickleball on the neighbors. The survey is very short and should only take a couple of minutes to complete. For residents affected by pickleball that would like to see reduced hours of play, we have provided three scheduling options. We ask that you review and rate the three options.
