Since the product has already been bid at the national level, individual schools do not have to duplicate the formal bid process.

EXCLUSIONS:

- a) The base upon which the FieldTurf field will be placed. FieldTurf shall not be responsible for the stability, the porosity, nor the approval of the base upon which the FieldTurf surface will be installed, the drainage system, nor any construction or modification of existing installations around the fields.
- b) The supply or installation of the field edging
- c) Any costs associated with necessary charges relating to the delineation of the field
- d) Unless otherwise specified, does not include any G-max testing but warranties ASTM g-max compliance with F-1936-10 upon completion.
- e) The supply of manholes or clean-outs or grates, or supply of the manhole covers; and
- f) Any alteration or deviation from specifications involving extra costs, which alteration or deviation will be provided only upon executed change orders, and will become an extra charge over and above the offered price.
- g) Any electrical work
- h) Unsuitable soils: once sub-grade has been established, a proof roll will be performed to ensure structural stability of the soils; in the event that unsuitable soils are encountered, a price to remedy these areas can be negotiated.
- i) Relocation, removal and repair of existing utilities not limited to electrical conduits, power poles, water, sewer, gas, cable, telephone, owner placed conduits or communication feeds within the field of play
- j) Design services and construction documentation, including, but not limited to: conceptual drawings/preliminary design; construction drawings; storm water management; submittal reviews and processing; architectural/engineering inspections; soil borings; professional survey; and as-built drawings.
- k) All applicable taxes, prevailing wages, union labor or other labor law levies. Owner to provide a tax exempt certificate.
- l) Logos or additional sport markings other than noted as included
- m) Replacement or modification to the existing perimeter nailer board
- n) FieldTurf is not altering or improving the existing drainage under the existing turf limits. No repairs, removal, milling, ponding or flooding within the existing base is included and will remain the responsibility of the owner. Field Turf will, at the direction and alternate acceptance of the owner, hire an independent agency to perform drainage tests on the existing dynamic base to determine its ability to drain properly. See above allowance of \$2500.
- o) FieldTurf maintenance equipment
- p) Small vehicle to tow Field Turf maintenance equipment
- q) Fencing, gates, grass restoration

NOTES:

Notwithstanding any other document or agreement entered into by Field Turf in connection with the supply and installation only of its product pursuant to the present bid proposal, the following shall apply:

- a) This bid proposal and its acceptance is subject to strikes, accidents, delays beyond our control and *force majeure*;
- b) Final payment shall be upon the substantial completion of Field Turf’s obligations;
- c) Accounts overdue beyond 30 days of invoice date will be charged at an interest rate of 1.5% per month (19.56% per annum);

- d) Field Turf requires a minimum of 21 days after receiving final approvals on shop drawings to manufacture, coordinate delivery and schedule arrival of installation crew. Under a typical field size and scenario, FieldTurf further requires approximately 120 days unencumbered access to the field to complete the field, subject to weather, other delays beyond the control of Field Turf and *force majeure*.
- e) FieldTurf requires a suitable staging area. Staging area must be square footage of field x 0.12, have a minimum access of 15 feet wide by 15 feet high, and, no more than 100ft from the site. A 25 foot wide by 25 foot long hard or paved clean surface area located within 50 feet of the playing surface shall be provided for purposes of proper mixing of infill material. Access to any field will include suitable bridging over curbs from the staging area to permit suitable access to the field by low clearance vehicles.
- f) This proposal is based on a single mobilization. If the site is not ready and additional mobilizations are necessary, additional charges will apply.
- g) FieldTurf shall be accountable for its negligence but shall not be bound by any penalty clauses.
- h) FieldTurf shall be entitled to recover all costs and expenses, including attorney fees, associated with collection procedures in the event that Field Turf pursues collection of payment of any past due invoice.
- i) An 8 year 3rd party pre-paid insured warranty on the FieldTurf artificial grass surface; with exception on the home plate area, base paths and pitcher’s mound which shall be 2 years instead of 8 years and there is no third party insurance.
- j) All colors are to be chosen from Field Turf’s standard colors.

The price is valid for a period of 90 days. The price is subject to increase if affected by an increase in raw materials, freight, or other manufacturing costs, a tax increase, new taxes, levies or any new legally binding imposition affecting the transaction. The price of the base preparation is subject to increase in the event Field Turf encounters any of the following site conditions: soil contamination; bedrock; unknown utilities; underground springs; unstable or unsuitable ground; and any concealed or unknown conditions.
