- Enhance signage to improve curb appeal






Physical Constraints

- Topography of existing site in relation to adjacent right of way

Project Direction

- Façade
 - Color and textures to increase visibility of retail spaces
- Accessibility
 - Relocate ADA parking spaces for an improved path of travel
- Signage
 - Renovate pylon at the intersection of Cedar & Park
 - Improve tenant signage for better visibility
 - Enhance signage for second floor offices
- Landscaping
 - Landscape islands along drive access lane and at the perimeter of parking lot
 - Bio-retention islands
 - Plantings and trees




