You are proposing to limit pickleball, which is being heavily used and is growing in popularity, rather than proposing options that will accommodate and support the broad community which is currently playing at Glyndon. To ameliorate the impact on the surrounding community (who bought homes next to a public park and apparently find it inconvenient when that park is being used!), you should consider installing noise-dampening acoustic cloths around the court in the short run, and -- more importantly -- seek a long-term solution by providing other pickleball facilities in Vienna, perhaps by building purpose-built pickleball courts at South Park. Then, and only then, should a move to further restrict pickleball play at Glyndon be considered.</p> <p>Also, elimination of court reservations reduces an important option for town residents who pay the taxes for Vienna recreational facilities. This should be reconsidered.</p> <p>Finally, the Town also seems to still find it difficult to comprehend that forcing advanced and beginner players to share the same facilities at the same time for "open play" means that advanced players will not come, as they cannot be assured of competitive and challenging court play. Every time the Town has restricted pickleball play at Glyndon, it has been at the expense of the intermediate/advanced players.</p>

There are a large number of pickleball players here who live either within the Town liimits or nearby in Fairfax County. During the spring, summer and fall months, there would often be as many as 40 or more players wanting to play at the same time in the mornings before it gets too hot. Survey: Currently, play occurs seven days a week. Reducing it to M,W, F in option 1 or M, W, Sat in option 2 would be undesirable and deprive players of the opportunity they currently have to play and get healthy exercise and fellowshipo while at Glyndon. Reservation system: More advanced players especially like to know that a court will be available if they come. The reservation system in the afternoons is desirable for that reason. Taking it away is a step backwards. As a Vienna taxpayer, the benefit of being able to make a reservation should not be taken away. Lighting: In the winter months when it gets dark so early, players should be allowed to use the lights after 5pm - at least until 6pm and preferably until 8pm. After all, the ballfield lights are used during those early evening hours. The sport is rapidly growing in popularity. The Town should be making an effort to accommodate that growth. The proposal reflected in the survey is a step in the wrong direction.</p>
