

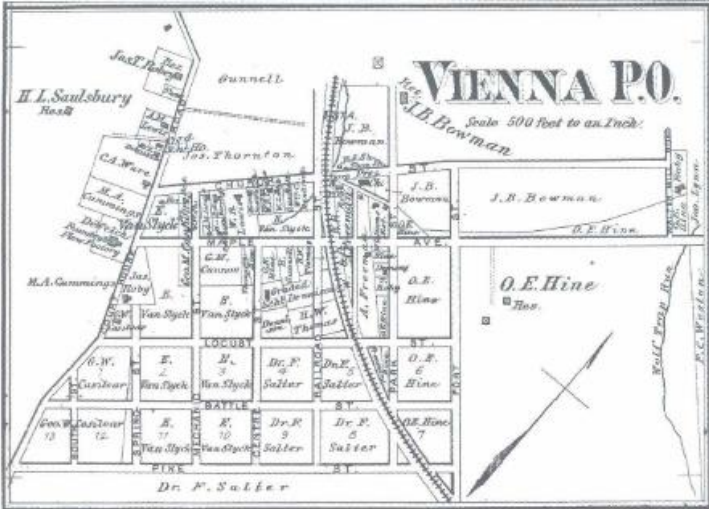
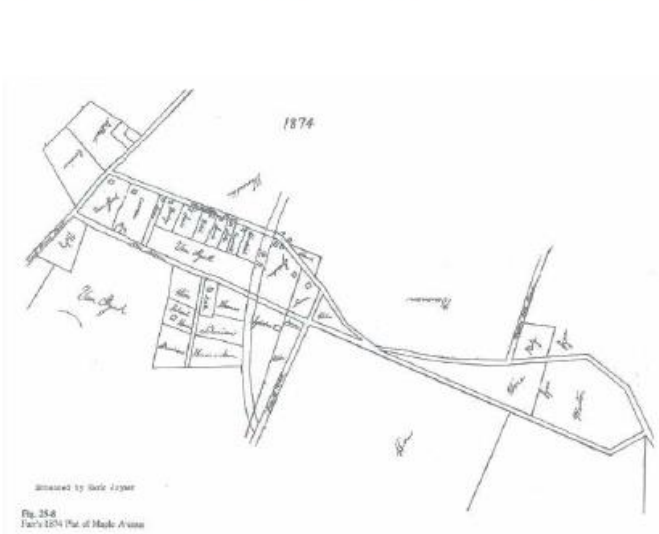

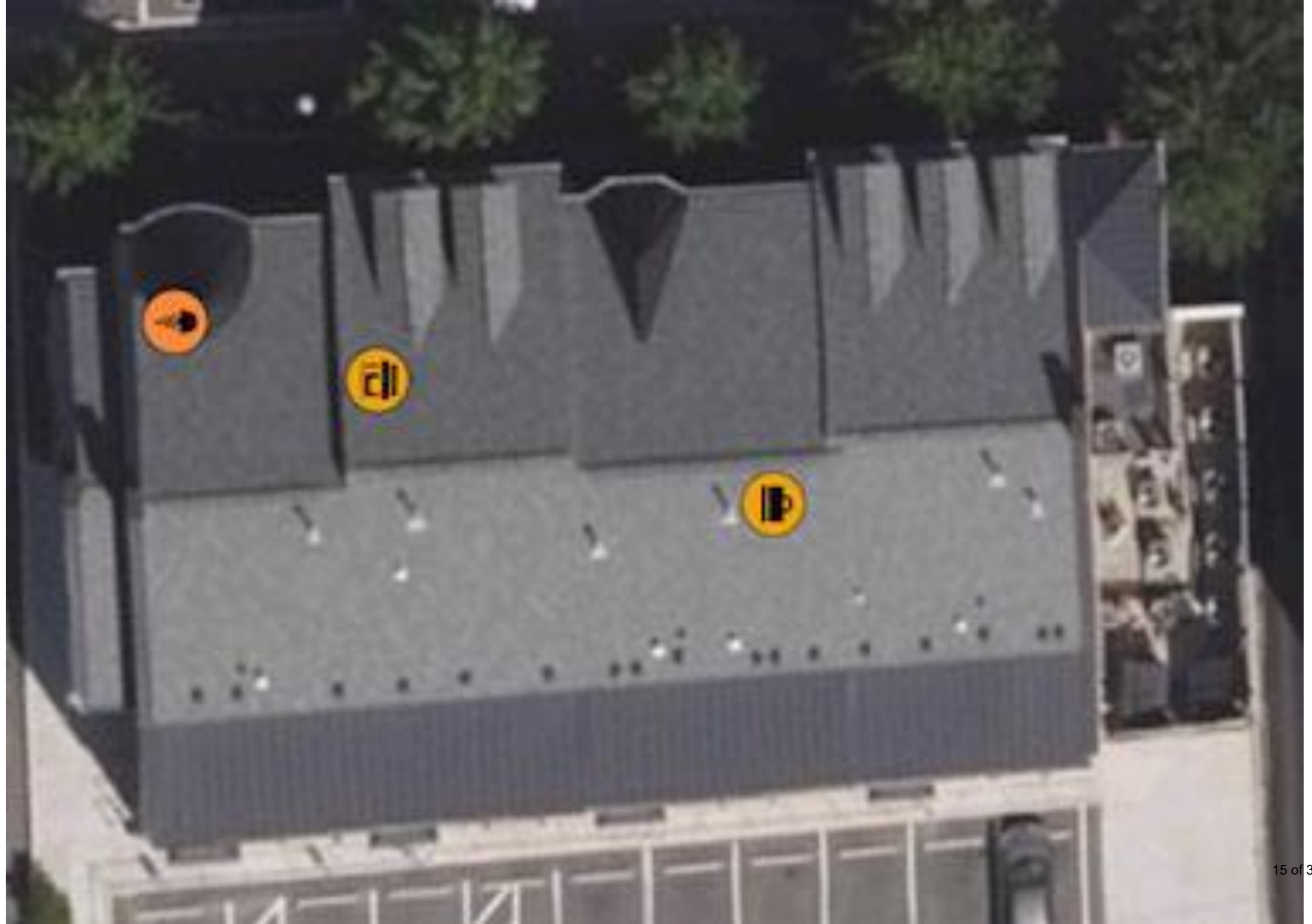

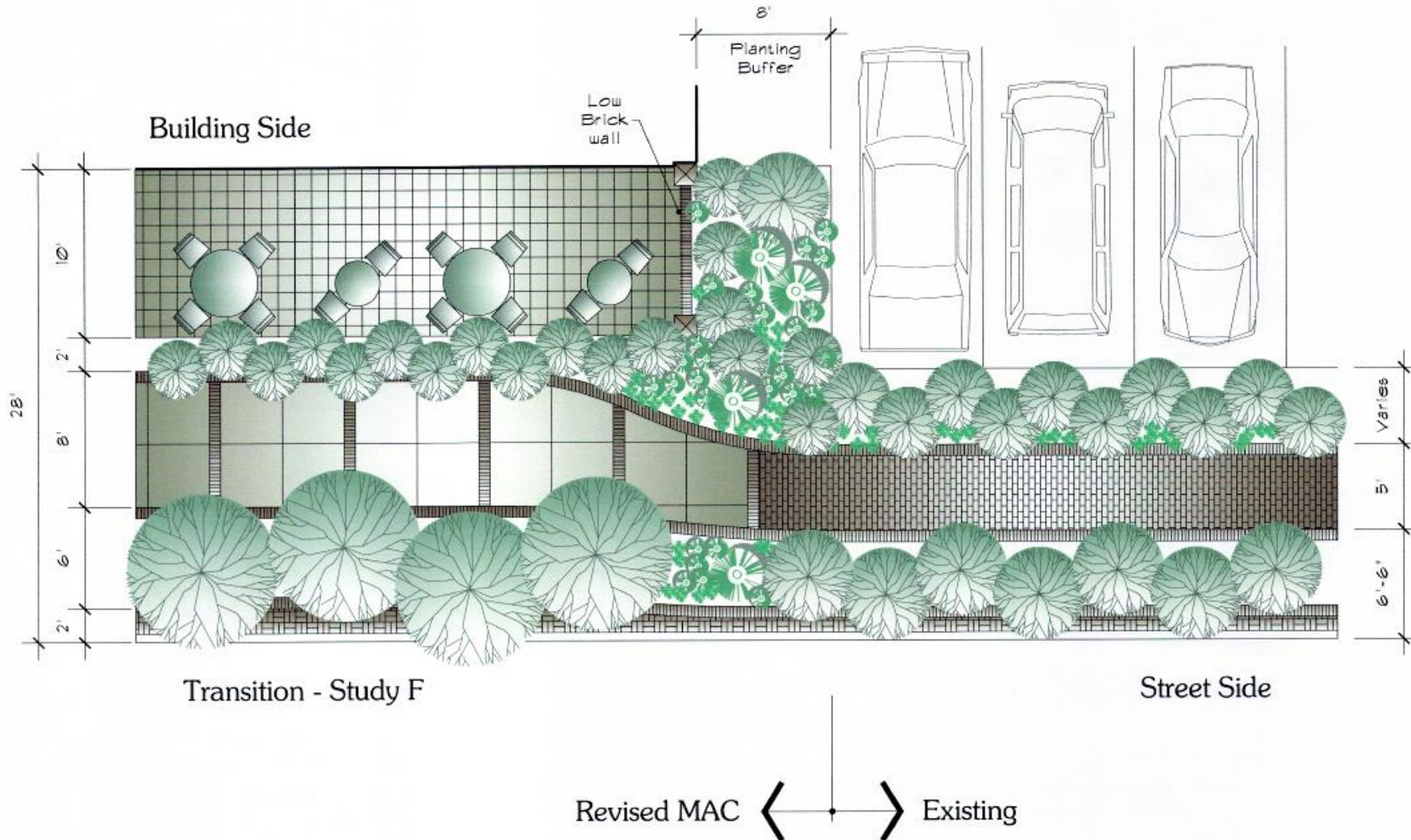




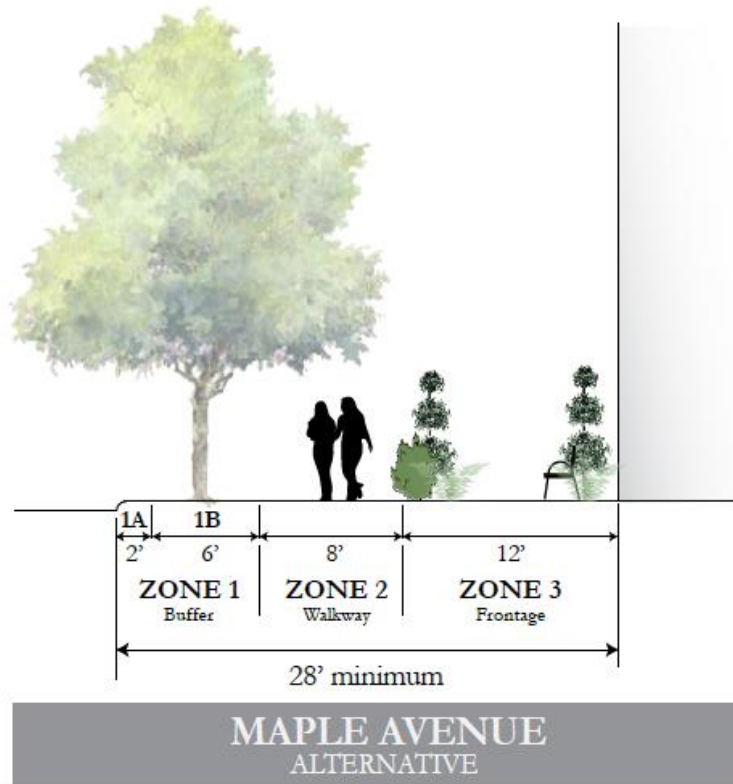




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Diagrammatic Streetscape Plan Studies: 1/4" = 1'-0"
