Dear Property Owner,

At their October 15, 2018 meeting at 8 PM in the Town Hall Council Chamber, the Vienna Town Council will consider authorizing the Tapawingo/Kingsley Urban Bioretention funding agreement, along with the survey and design contract. This project is located within the right-of-way at the intersections of Tapawingo Road SW and Meadow Lane SW and Kingsley Road SW and Meadow Lane SW. Urban bioretention facilities will be placed in new curb extensions functioning as traffic calming measures, per the January 30, 2018 Transportation Safety Commission (TSC) motion.

You are welcome to attend the Council meeting. A copy of the Public Works Department's report recommending the project will be available after 2PM on the Friday before the meeting on the Town Council website located at https://www.viennava.gov/index.aspx?NID=567.

If Town Council authorizes the funding agreement and contracts, the next step will be a field survey and design plan preparation. As the plans are being prepared, owners of properties affected by the work will receive copies of the plans addressing any impacts to properties. You will receive notice of community design meetings to review and discuss the plans, as well as the Town Council meeting when the construction contract award is considered.
