## **PROPOSED ORDINANCE**

## **Proposed by: Town Attorney**

A proposed ordinance to amend Chapter 10, Offenses, Miscellaneous, Article 3 – Offenses Against Property, Section 10-22, Petit larceny, of the Code of the Town of Vienna.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VIENNA, VIRGINIA THAT:

**Section 1**: The Town Code, Chapter 10, Offenses, Miscellaneous, Article 3 – Offenses Against Property, Section 10-22, Petit larceny, is amended to include newly enacted State law monetary amounts and to read as follows:

Sec. 10-22. - Petit larceny.

Any person who commits larceny from the person of another of money or other thing of value of less than \$5.00, or commits simple larceny not from the person of another of goods and chattels of the value of less than \$200.00 \$500.00, except as provided in Code of Virginia, \$ 18.2-95(iii), shall be deemed guilty of petit larceny, which shall be punishable as a Class 1 misdemeanor.

State Law reference— Similar state law, Code of Virginia, § 18.2-96.

**Section 2**: This Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days following notice of adoption by the Town Council.
