Subject: Shared Mobility Devices (SMD) Pilot Program

Date: December 4, 2019

At their October 29, 2019 meeting, the Transportation Safety Commissions (TSC) heard a presentation from the Department of Public Works (DPW) summarizing the proposed SMD pilot program. Following the presentation, the TSC provided feedback and questions to DPW then opened to the floor for public comments.

During the November 26, 2019 TSC meeting, DPW reviewed the adjustments made to the SMD pilot program documents based on comments from the previous TSC meeting and answered questions from the previous TSC meeting.

Following a discussion, the TSC approved the following motion:

“The Transportation Safety Commission (TSC) supports the SMD pilot program and documents associated with the program, as amended. Documents include: SMD Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), SMD Permit Application, and SMD Pilot Summary. TSC recommends Town Council to support the SMD pilot program and documents associated with the program.”

The motion was made by Vice Chair Beth Eachus, seconded by Commissioner Loginn Kapitan, and carried by a vote of 8 to 0. Commissioner Charlie Strunk was not in attendance.
