LB Food Market – 303A Mill Street NE

Item No. 4: Request for approval of a new wall sign for LB Food Market located at 303A Mill Street NE, Docket No. PF-55-19-BAR, in the CM Limited Industrial District zoning district; filed by Rawad Hasrouni, of RLR LLC, operator.

The applicant is requesting an internally illuminated channel letter wall sign for the new LB Food Market located at 303A Mill Street NE; the LB Food Market is located within the space previously occupied by Bey Lounge. The sign area is 28 square feet in area total; the sign meets the regulations of the Town Code.

The sign consists of the “LB” logo above the words “Food Market” mounted on 6” by 6” raceway painted to match the existing color of the wall. The sign is constructed of 3/16” white acrylic faces, dark brown returns, and black trim molding.

The sign will be illuminated with red LED modules; the total lumens is to be provided by the applicant. The application states that the interior of the channel letters is to be painted white for maximum lighting.

Process

Per Town Code Chapter 4, all land areas zoned other than single-family detached residential are architectural control districts. Any lot, parcel or area of land within any area zoned for single-family detached residences, which is used for other than single-family detached residences, or which is the subject of an application for a use permit or

building permit involving any such other use, is also designated an architectural control district.

No structure, building, sign or other improvements or other major landscape features surrounding such building, structure, sign or improvement located on any land within any architectural control district shall be erected, reconstructed, altered or restored until the plans for such shall have been approved by the Board of Architectural Review.
