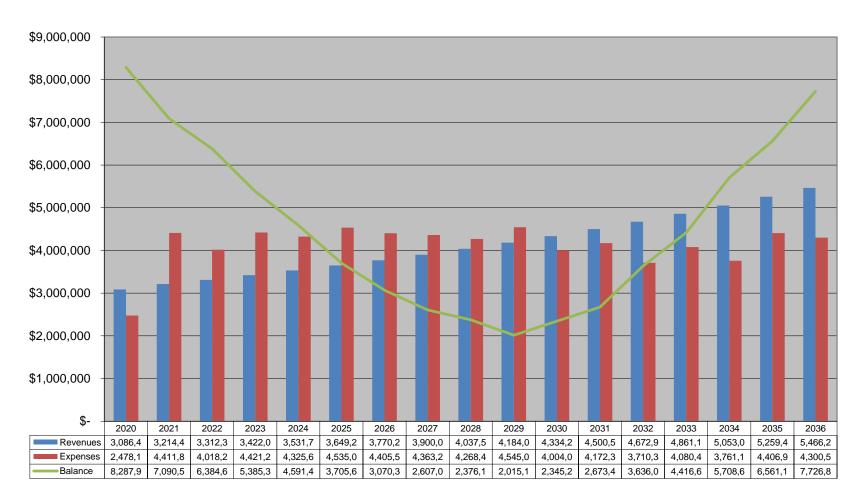

# CIP FY 2020 – 2036 Assumptions for Debt Model For Approval 2/24/2020

- 1. Debt Issuance every two years. Interest rate estimated at 2.5% for FY 2020 & 2022, 3.0% for FY 2024 & 2026, 3.5% for FY 2028 & 2030, 4% for FY 2032 & 2034 and 4.5% for FY 2036.
- 2. Meals tax revenue, which funds debt payments, projected to grow at 3.75% a year, with the exception of a projected bump for new restaurants in 2020. Projecting 5% growth in 2020 and 4% growth in 2021. All years 2022 through 2036 growth projected at 3.75%.
- 3. Meals tax rate will remain at 3.0%, the current tax rate.
- 4. The plan supports a \$14.9 million police station construction and project management in the 2020 bond.
- 5. The plan includes funding for two property acquisitions funded in 2020. One was purchased in December, 2019, and one is proposed for the spring of 2020, partially funded by bond premium.
- 6. The plan includes two public parking structures. One in conjunction with Fairfax County at the Patrick Henry Library, construction funded by NVTC grant and one with a private partner at Church and Lawyers Roads partially funded by an NVTA grant.
- 7. The 2020 bond has a 20-year debt schedule; all other issues have 15-year debt schedules.
- 8. Asphalt & Mill Overlay and Miscellaneous Public Improvements are funded in each bond issue, increasing by 3.0% per issue.
- 9. Parks Master Plan is funded at \$100,000 in 2020 followed by annual funding of \$100,000 for a Parks Opportunity Fund from 2022 2036.
- 10. Water and sewer projects, funded by water and sewer rates included at \$5.4 million in 2020 bond fund, increasing by 2.5% per issue.
- 11. Reserve for undergrounding power lines of \$500,000 per bond issue beginning in 2024.
- 12. Items marked with an asterisk (\*) in the "Project Change" column in the CIP detail have changed since the 2019 approved presentation.
