Dear Town of Vienna,

We are writing to address the proposal to add sidewalks to Delano Dr. We greatly appreciate the gift given to the town by Mrs. Robinson and agree that additional sidewalks in areas of Vienna would improve our community. However, we don't believe that sidewalks would benefit our neighborhood, have surveyed our neighbors, and believe the majority of residents on the street feel the same way.

In conducting our door to door survey, the following two questions were asked and results by household are provided on the attached and below. *NOTE: Due to COVID, we decided to just verbally asked residents the questions listed below and did not prepare a petition.*

- **Do you want sidewalks on Delano Dr? Yes, No, or No Preference:**
 - 2 – No response
 - 2 – No preference for sidewalks
 - 3 – Yes, sidewalks installed on Delano Dr.
 - **7 – No, sidewalks installed on Delano Dr.**
- **If the town moves forward with Sidewalks, then what side of the street would you prefer- Odd, Even, or No Preference:**
 - 1 – If sidewalk, install on Odd side of street
 - 2 – No response
 - 3 – No preference and can be installed on either side
 - **8 – If sidewalk, install on Even side of street**

We also attended the July 30th meeting on this issue with other residents of Delano attendees. The meeting attendees advocated for no sidewalks and this response is in line with the door to door survey results. **Of the 12 residents surveyed, 7 residents voted for No Sidewalks.** If the town chooses to move forward with the sidewalk on Delano Dr, then **8 of the 12 residents surveyed requested that sidewalks are installed on the even side of the street.**

While Delano has some foot traffic, car traffic is light and cars are generally slow moving. We are also concerned that if sidewalks are added on the odd side the street, that 8 single car-wide driveways on the street will be shortened resulting in many more cars parked in the street worsening both traffic and also worsening pedestrian safety. Here are some notes based on discussions with residents:

- There are 11 homes on odd side of street with driveways that will be impacted.

- Of the 11 homes on the odd side of the street, 8 homes have single car-wide, short driveways that will be impacted. Most of the single car-wide homes park two cars in their driveway.
- There are 3 homes on even side the street have two car driveways, no single car driveways will be impacted.
- There will likely be increased number of cars parked on the street due to inability to park cars in driveway to allow for sidewalk access.
- If a sidewalk is installed on the even side of street, it will line up with Orrin sidewalk project.

Thank you for considering these points and the neighborhood's perspective and for your service to our town.
