





SUBJECT: TO HAVE OR NOT TO HAVE SIDEWALKS ON ORRIN STREET, SE, VIENNA, VA 22180

As a homeowner on Orrin Street, S.E., I responded to the March Survey that my wife and I do not want sidewalks on our street. The reasons we do not want them is as follows:

1. A sidewalk would minimize the size and "green" of our already shallow front yards.
2. Construction of a sidewalk would be messy and disruptive.
3. Out of the approximate 25 homes on Orrin, there are 6 new home, 2 recently improved and 17 original homes. Presumably, there will be more teardowns in the coming months and years during which the road (and sidewalk) will be disturbed for access to water and sewer.
4. A sidewalk would take away from the original quaintness of Vienna's rural feeling in the neighborhood – a draw which attracted us to the neighborhood and I am sure contributed to the decision to buy by the new street homeowners. Instead, a sidewalk would present a "cookie-cutter" look of a development versus a small-town neighborhood.
5. A sidewalk would take away off-street parking in driveways from homes on the sidewalk side since parking is not supposed to block the sidewalk (and may even be illegal).
6. A sidewalk would put the burden on the homeowner to shovel/clear snow from the sidewalk in front of one's house.
7. It is a quiet street and not a rush-hour or pass-through street.
8. There are no residential properties on Follin beyond Echols. Sidewalks would only bring office personnel from Offices. It would not be serving Vienna Residents.
9. We are appreciative that curbs already exist. Orrin is private; Sidewalk will only bring more people and the potential for possible crime.

It would seem more logical for the Town to put sidewalks on the streets that connect directly to Maple Avenue, such as Berry and East Streets, S.E.

**IF A SIDEWALK IS PUT ON ORRIN**

Has the decision already been made to add a sidewalk to Orrin (and Delano)? Do the residents actually have a "vote" on this?

How many Orrin residents responded to your March Survey? How many responded yes to the sidewalk?

If a sidewalk goes in on Orrin, will the utilities be put underground? If not, why not?

If a decision has been or is made to put a sidewalk on Orrin, I do NOT want it on my side. I already have the burden of an ugly telephone pole on the corner of my yard with low wires leading to my house. In this regard, all the new properties have underground utilities. The Town should ensure that if a sidewalk goes in, all the utilities on Orrin be underground for safety purposes and the poles be removed.
