A. <u>20-1887</u>	Resolution for Continuity of Government	
	Mayor Linda Colbert read into the record the Continuity of Government. The	
	Resolution was approved through voice vote.	
<b>B.</b> <u>20-1928</u>	Discuss Amendments to Temporary Sign Regulations	
	Mayor Colbert called on Cindy Petkac, Director of Planning and Zoning to provide	
	background and timeline for amendments to the temporary sign ordinance. She also	
	set forth proposed language changes for consideration.	
	Council agreed that the issues of size, duration and neutrality were all addressed in	
	the changes, but issues related to permanent signs and enforcement were not.	
	Council Member Somers stressed the need for clarity in the ordinance. He noted that	
	there is no mention of temporary window signs and suggested that window and yard	
	signage should be treated the same. Director Petkac confirmed that the language	
	addresses permanent window signage only and suggested that with the zoning	
	rewrite, this could be addressed.	
	Following discussion, Mayor Colbert offered a suggestion for the regulation of	
	temporary signs as follows:	
	0-12 square feet; duration unlimited;	
	13-21 square feet; duration 30 days;	
	22- 54 square feet; duration 7 days.	
	No single sign can measure over 4 square feet.	
	Understanding that enforcement would remain complaint based, Council approved	
	this new language.	

The proposed amendments will be brought under consideration by Planning and

Zoning at the December 9, 2020 meeting. A Public Hearing will be scheduled for January 2021.
