

Proposed Temporary Sign Definitions

TEMPORARY SIGN: A sign constructed of cloth, canvas, vinyl, paper, plywood, fabric, or other lightweight material not well suited to provide a durable substrate or, if made of some other material, is neither permanently installed in the ground nor permanently affixed to a building or structure which is permanently installed in the ground.

WINDOW SIGN: A sign visible outside the window and attached to or within eighteen (18) inches in front of or behind the surface of a window or door.

YARD SIGN: A temporary sign placed upon or supported by the ground independently of any other structure, or affixed to a framework or flat surface.

YARD SIGN, NON-COMMERCIAL (CONSTRUCTION, FOR SALE, RENT, OR LEASE): A temporary sign placed upon or supported by the ground independently of any other structure, or affixed to a framework or flat surface during the duration of construction or sale, rent or lease of a property.
