Work Session Reviewing Draft of Planning Commission Bylaws and rules of procedure

Reviewing draft language with the Town Attorney, commission discussion suggestions included keeping state code language within the document with each section concluding with pertinent state code section and hyperlink to the code. Additional discussion included topics include formatting, rules of procedures to include section 15.2-22.3 for all necessary comprehensive plan requirements, preparation of an annual report per state code, and comparison language to surrounding jurisdictions. Additional discussion questions included whether to commissioner training should be required or encouraged.

A follow-up work session has been scheduled for February 13, 2019 to begin at 6:30 pm, at which time the commission will also discuss the proposed MAC application for 374-380 Maple Avenue West. Staff will provide updated draft bylaw language for review.
