Mayor DiRocco introduced Marion Serfass, Director of Finance to present the first item of regular business, Intent to Adopt FY2020-2021 Water and Sewer Rate. Director Serfass noted that a public hearing was held on April 13, 2020 to allow public comment on the new rates. She further emphasized that the current COVID crisis has little effect on this rate, so it was thought prudent to place this item up for adoption tonight. The Finance Department requests that Council approve the rates as proposed, effective July 1, 2020.

It was moved to approve an ordinance setting water and sewer rates for fiscal year 2020-21, beginning July 1, 2020, as presented.
