Ms. Biles reached out to the owners but has not heard back.

<u>VPAC21-080</u> Musical sculpture garden update

• Ms. Cousins reached out to several Ayr Hill Garden Club members to inform them about the project, and heard back from one, Anne Stuntz. Ms. Cousins will contact the Children's Discovery Garden Coordinator.

• Ms. Bruno reported on making contact with a company called Kaplan Co.com. Musical instrument price quote is approximately \$18,000. She will get installation quote-needs picture with dimensions of proposed area (20'Wide, 12'Deep on one side, 12'Deep on other side, 18'Deep in the middle).

• *Ms. Aglio mentioned the need to determine what percentage of VPAF funds will be spent on the project.*

• *Ms. Biles suggested holding off on fundraising efforts until spring 2022 due to the uptick in covid-19*
