409 Beulah Road NW subdivision performance bond reduction request

### EXPLANATION AND SUMMARY :

JDA Custom Homes has requested a performance bond reduction for completed improvements associated with the 409 Beulah Road NW subdivision project. Completed improvements have been inspected and approved by the DPW engineer.

DPW recommends that the surety amount be reduced from the original \$39,684.17 to \$3,968.42, which will be held until issuance of the last occupancy permit, at which time the bond will be reduced to a two-year maintenance bond.
