Request CIP and revenue-share funding for roadway maintenance utilizing IFB 20-03

EXPLANATION AND SUMMARY :

DPW requests \$869,500 in funding for roadway maintenance with Arthur Construction, utilizing IFB 20-03. The requested funds are for roadway maintenance of various Town streets. The funding will come from the CIP 2020 bond (\$300,000) and VDOT Revenue Sharing (\$539,000 with \$269,500 reimbursement).

CIP 2020 Bond - \$300,000

Revenue Sharing - \$539,000 (subject to 50% reimbursement)

Total Funding - \$839,000
